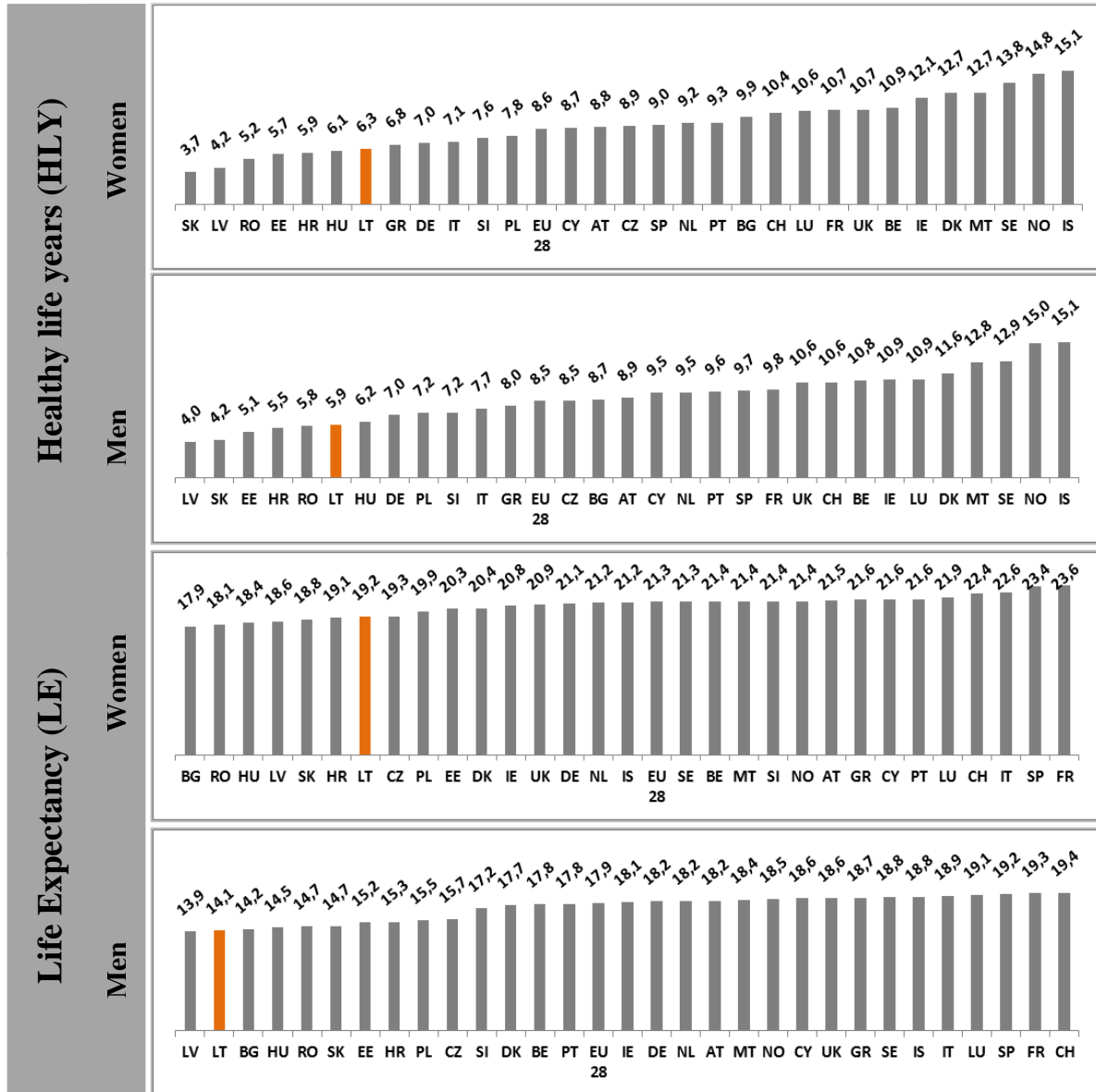


## Healthy Life Years (HLY) and Life Expectancy (LE) at the age of 65 in European Countries based on SILC 2013



### Key points:

Life Expectancy for Lithuanian men at the age of 65 was 14.1 years, and for women of the same age – 19.2 years. Although women were doing much better with regard to LE, both estimates (for men and women) were lower than the EU 28 average.

According to 2013 SILC data, Lithuanian men and women at the age of 65 could have expected to live 5.9 and 6.3 years in good health, accordingly. Compared with other countries' estimates, Lithuania's HLY was lower than the EU 28 average (EU 28 8,5years for men and 8 years for women) and was similar for both sexes, but better than other Baltic countries.
